About the Club

Heyside Juniors, we were formed in 1975. We are run under the Heyside FC Constitution, running rules and Code of conduct which can be viewed online at www.heysidefc.co.uk. We are England Football Accredited and have the highest recognition as a 3 star club.

- All our Coaches and Volunteers requiring a DBS (CRB) check have been appropriately checked and hold an FA Enhanced DBS Certification.

All Coaches are DBS(CRB) checked and required to pass an FA Introduction to Coaching Football qualification within 6 months of joining the club. The Coaches must also have completed Safeguarding Children Workshop or Player Welfare in Open Age Football.

We greatly appreciate the role that you play in helping your son or daughter to enjoy their football here at Heyside Football Club. To be successful we need your help and support. The club is run by volunteers who give up their time freely. Off the pitch the Club Committee will always endeavour to provide the best environment and opportunities for young people to enjoy their football.
